

KEY FOB WITH FOUNDATION PIECING

Requirements

One foundation pieced front 1¼" wide

One backing 1¼" x 9"

Wadding ⅞" x 9"

Key hardware or D Ring and key ring.

Instructions

Make up foundation pieced front, add a piece of material 1" x 2" on each end if using D Ring*.

Put RST with a 1¼" x 9" backing strip and sew down each side. It will bulge at the back but this creates an edge at the front.

Turn through to right side and iron.

Feed through the wadding (⅞" x 9")

Top stitch either side.

Fold in half and attach Key hardware

If using D Ring

Stop ½" from the folded end, trim wadding slightly shorter than the length.

Feed swivel clip or D ring onto the fabric.

Stuff raw end into folded end to create a loop – pin – sew in place and then finish the top stitching.

Place the swivel clip/D ring into the seam end and sew or fix in place.

*If using Ruth's foundation pattern extra has been allowed for a D ring so this will need to be removed if using key hardware. Otherwise you could make a slightly longer key fob!

The striped one is from the kits we sell in Region 11, and the Flying Geese one came from a website Michael Ann Made which is no longer available.
